

- 12:20 now there were seven brothers; and the first took a wife, and dying left no descendants  
 12:21 and the second took her, and died, neither left he any descendants; and the third likewise  
 12:22 and the seven had her, and left no descendants; last of all the woman died also  
 12:23 therefore in the resurrection, when they shall rise, whose wife will she be of them  
 for the seven had her to wife  
 12:24 and Yeshua answering said to them  
 do you not therefore err, because you know not the Scriptures, neither the power of God  
 12:25 for when they rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage  
 but are as the angels who are in heaven  
 12:26 and as touching the dead, that they rise  
 have you not read in the scroll of Mosheh, how in the bush God spake to him, saying > Exodus 3:6,15  
 I [am] the God of Avraham, and the God of Yitzchak, and the God of Ya`akov  
 12:27 He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living  
 you therefore do greatly err
- TWO LAW COMMANDMENTS
- 12:28 and one of the Law-scholars came, and having heard them reasoning together  
 and perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him: which is the first commandment of all > Loukas 10:25  
 12:29 and Yeshua answered him  
 the first of all the commandments [is]  
 Shema Israel, Adonai Eloheynu, Adonai Echad > The Shema, Deuteronomy 6:4  
 [Hear Israel, Lord God of us, Lord One] Hear Israel Yehovah our Elohim [is] one Yehovah  
 12:30 and you shall love the Lord your God  
 with all your heart and  
 with all your soul, and  
 with all your mind, and  
 with all your strength  
 this [is] the first commandment  
 12:31 and the second [is] like, [namely] this > Leviticus 19:18; Galatians 5:14; Ya`akov 2:8  
 you shall love your neighbor as yourself  
 there is none other commandment greater than these  
 12:32 and the Law-scholar said to Him: well Teacher, You have said the truth  
 for there is one God, and there is none other but He > Deuteronomy 4:35  
 12:33 and to love Him > Hoshea 6:6  
 with all the heart, and  
 with all the understanding, and  
 with all the soul, and  
 with all the strength  
 and to love [his] neighbor as himself  
 is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices  
 12:34 and when Yeshua saw that he answered wisely, He said to him  
 you are not far from the kingdom of God  
 and no one dared to question Him any more
- DA`VID'S LORD
- 12:35 and Yeshua answered and said  
 while He taught in the temple  
 how say the Law-scholars that the Messiah is the Son of Da`vid  
 12:36 for Da`vid himself said by the Holy Spirit > Psalm 110:1  
 Yehovah said to my Lord: sit on My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool  
 12:37 Da`vid therefore himself calls Him Lord; and from where is He his son  
 BEWARE THE LAW-SCHOLARS  
 and the common people heard Him gladly  
 12:38 and He said to them in His teaching  
 beware of the Law-scholars, who love to go in long clothing, and [love] greetings in the marketplaces  
 12:39 and the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at feasts  
 12:40 who devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers; these shall receive greater damnation  
 WIDOW'S LEPTA
- 12:41 and Yeshua sat over against the treasury  
 and beheld how the people threw money into the treasury; and many who were rich threw in much  
 12:42 and there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two lepta, which make a kodrantes  
 12:43 and He called [to Him] His pupils, and says to them  
 assuredly I say to you, that this poor widow has thrown more in  
 than all those throwing into the treasury  
 12:44 for all [they] did throw in of their abundance  
 but she of her want did throw in all that she had, [even] all her living  
 TEMPLE TO BE DESTROYED
- 13:1 and as He went out of the temple, one of His pupils says to Him  
 Teacher, see what manner of stones and what buildings [are here]  
 13:2 and Yeshua answering said to him  
 you see these great buildings, there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down  
 LAST DAYS >
- 13:3 and as He sat upon the hill of Olives opposite the temple  
 13:4 Kaifa and Ya`akov and Yochanan and Anderai asked Him privately  
 tell us, when shall these things be, and what [shall be] the sign when all these things shall be fulfilled  
 13:5 and Yeshua answering them began to say  
 take heed lest any one deceive you  
 13:6 for many will come in My name, saying: I AM; and will deceive many  
 13:7 and when you hear of wars and rumors of wars  
 be not troubled; for [such things] must needs be; but the end [is] not yet  
 13:8 for ethnics will rise against ethnics, and kingdom against kingdom and > Loukas 21:10  
 there will be earthquakes in various places and  
 there will be famines and troubles  
 these [are] the beginnings of sorrows  
 13:9 but take heed to yourselves > Matai 10:17; Loukas 12:11  
 for they will deliver you up to Sanhedrins; and  
 you will be beaten in the synagogues; and
