

23:40 but the other answering rebuked him, saying: do you not fear God, seeing you are in the same condemnation 23:41 and we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong 23:42 and he said to Yeshua: Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom 23:43 and Yeshua said to him: truly I say to you, today you will be with Me in paradise 23:44 and it was about noon and there was a darkness over all the earth until three in the afternoon 23:45 and the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two parts down the center 23:46 and when Yeshua had cried with a loud voice, He said: Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit and having said thus, He breathed out the spirit 23:47 now when the captain of a hundred soldiers saw what was done, he glorified God, saying: certainly this Man was righteous 23:48 and all the people who came together to that sight, beholding the things which were done smote their breasts, and returned 23:49 and all His acquaintance, and the women who followed Him from Galil stood afar off, beholding these things

23:50 and behold, a man named Yosef, a counsellor; a good man, and just 23:51 the same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them [he was] of Ramatieyim, a city of the Yehudim; who also himself waited for the kingdom of God 23:52 this [man] went to Pilatos, and begged the body of Yeshua 23:53 and he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a tomb that was hewn in stone wherein never before was man laid 23:54 and that day was the preparation, and Shabat was coming or 23:55 and the women also, who came with Him from Galil, followed after and beheld the tomb, and how His body was laid 23:56 and they returned, and prepared spices and ointments and they rested on the Shabat according to the commandment

24:1 and on first of the week, before sunrise, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain [others] with them

three in the afternoon 15:34 and at three in the afternoon Yeshua cried with a loud voice, saying: Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani; which is, being interpreted, My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me 15:35 and some of those who stood by, when they heard [it], said: behold, He calls Eliyahu 15:36 and one ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, and put [it] on a reed, and gave Him to drink, saying: leave; let us see whether Eliyahu will come to take Him down 15:37 and Yeshua cried with a loud voice, and breathed out His life 15:38 and the veil of the temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom 15:39 and when the captain of a hundred soldiers who stood over against Him saw that He so cried out, and breathed out His life, he said: truly this Man was Son of God 15:40 there were also women looking on afar off among whom were Miryam from Magdala, and Miryam the mother of Ya'akov the less and of Yosi 15:41 and Shlomit, who also, when He was in Galil, followed Him, and ministered to Him and many other women who came up with Him to Yerushalyim 15:42 and now when the evening was come, because it was the preparation, that is, the day before the Shabat

15:43 Yosef of Ramatieyim, an honorable counsellor, who also waited for the kingdom of God came, and went in boldly to Pilatos, and craved the body of Yeshua 15:44 and Pilatos marvelled if He was already dead; and calling [to him] the captain of a hundred soldiers he asked him whether He had been any while dead 15:45 and when he knew [it] of the captain of a hundred soldiers, he gave the body to Yosef 15:46 and he bought fine linen, and took Him down, and wrapped Him in the linen and laid Him in a tomb which was cut out of rock, and rolled a stone to the door of the tomb 15:47 and Miryam from Magdala and Miryam [the mother] of Yosi beheld where He was laid

16:1 and when the Shabat was past, Miryam from Magdala, and Miryam the [mother] of Ya'akov, and Shlomit had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint Him 16:2 and very early in the morning, the first of the week

us see whether Eliyahu will come to save Him 27:50 Yeshua, when He had cried again with a loud voice, released the spirit 27:51 and behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom and the earth did quake, and the rocks were split 27:52 and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who slept arose, and 27:53 came out of the graves after His resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared to many 27:54 now when the captain of a hundred soldiers, and those who were with him, watching Yeshua saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying: truly this One was Son of God 27:55 and many women were there beholding afar off who followed Yeshua from Galil, ministering to Him 27:56 among whom were Miryam from Magdala, and Miryam the mother of Ya'akov and Yosef and the mother of the sons of Zavdai

27:57 when the evening was come, there came a rich man of Ramatieyim, named Yosef who also himself was Yeshua's pupil 27:58 he went to Pilatos, and begged the body of Yeshua then Pilatos commanded the body to be delivered 27:59 and when Yosef had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth 27:60 and he had hewn out in the rock and he rolled a great stone to the door of the tomb, and departed 27:61 and there was Miryam of Magdala, and the other Miryam, sitting over against the tomb 27:62 now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation the chief priests and Perushim came together to Pilatos, saying: 27:63 lord, we remember that that deceiver said, while He was yet alive after three days I will rise again 27:64 therefore command that the tomb be made sure until the third day, lest His pupils come by night, and steal Him away, and say to the people, He is risen from the dead; so the last error shall be worse than the first 27:65 Pilatos said to them: you have a guard-squad; go your way, make [it] as sure as you can 27:66 so they went, and made the tomb sure, sealing the stone, and setting the guard-squad

28:1 now late in the week, as it began to dawn into [the] first of [the] week Miryam of Magdala and the other Miryam came to see the tomb

mouth 19:30 then when Yeshua had received the sour wine, He said: it is finished; and He bowed His head, and delivered up the spirit 19:31 then the Jews, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the Shabat, for it was an important day, that Shabat, besought Pilatos that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away 19:32 then the soldiers came, and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who was crucified with Him 19:33 but when they came to Yeshua, and saw that He was dead already, they brake not His legs 19:34 but one of the soldiers with a spear pierced His side, and immediately there came out blood and water 19:35 and he who saw [it] bare record, and his record is true; and he knows that he said true, that you might believe 19:36 for these things were done, that the Scripture should be fulfilled a bone of Him shall not be broken 19:37 and again another Scripture said: they shall look on Him whom they pierced

19:38 and after this Yosef of Ramatieyim, being a pupil of Yeshua, but secretly for fear of the Jews besought Pilatos that he might take away the body of Yeshua; and Pilatos gave permission, then he came, and took the body of Yeshua 19:39 and there came also Nakdimon who at the first came to Yeshua by night, and brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about a hundred litras 19:40 then they took the body of Yeshua, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices as the manner of the Jews is to bury 19:41 now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden and in the garden a new tomb, wherein was never man yet laid 19:42 then they laid Yeshua there because of the Jews's preparation [day]; for the tomb was near

20:1 the first of the week Miryam of the Magdaliit comes early to the tomb,
